Brethren,

It is that time of year that we look at the Morlock Award. The award is presented to Lodges that have shown exemplary participation in giving to the Masonic Home. This award is presented to a Lodge in which at least 15% of the members each make gifts of \$5.00 or more in any one year. This award recognizes the number of active donors, not necessarily the total dollars given. The Masonic Home is convinced that as more Masons learn to support the Home, the dollar totals will follow.

This award is named in the memory of Most Worshipful Werner Herman Morlock, Grand Master of Masons in Virginia, 1993-1994.

This is the most significant award which can be presented to a Lodge for their gifts to the Masonic Home of Virginia.

The Masonic Home of Virginia is located at 500 Masonic Lane, Richmond, Virginia and was chartered by an act of the General Assembly of Virginia in January, 1890.

In December, 1889, Dr. George Potts a member of Astrea Lodge No.85 made several eloquent appeals to the committees and the Grand Lodge. Moved by the speech Captain A.G. Babcock offered \$5,000.00 in cash and a conditional pledge of further if the Home was established. It was passed by the Grand Lodge to authorize a Home for orphans of Virginia Master Masons. January 7, 1890 which is the date of the founding of the Masonic Home of Virginia.

Captain Babcock donated 44 ¹/₂ acres of excellent farming land on Nine Mile Road, with a dwelling of 10 rooms in good order, a large barn and stable recently built, and all of the necessary outhouses. Additional parcels of land were added by Captain Babcock and others to achieve 90 acres.

The Masonic Home raised 839 children of Virginia Master Masons from 1890 to 1975. And has cared for 1,200 adults since the adult division in 1955.
