An Entrance into the Imperishable Temple



"Architecture is one of the first occupations in which man employed himself. How astonishingly has the science of architecture improved and how honored and respected is an experienced architect! The science commenced with miserable huts; the next step was to erect altars on which to offer sacrifices to the gods; regular dwellings followed next in rotation, after which, in rapid succession, came palaces for princes, bridges over the most rapid streams to facilitate communication; pyramids and towers, proudly pointing to the heavens; catacombs of nearly immeasurable dimensions for the interment of their dead; and the most gorgeous temples in honor of the great architect of heaven and earth. Thus, we have adopted the title of Masons from one of the most ancient and most honorable occupations of mankind, in allusion to the antiquity of our order. The working tools of an Operative Mason have become our symbols, because we can find no better or more expressive ones. No occupation is so widely extended; and so closely connected with others, as that of a Mason; and the various paths by which mankind strive to gain an entrance into the imperishable temple are innumerable."
